Position: Shellfish Hatchery Algae Technician

Where: Taylor Shellfish Inc. Hatchery located on Dabob Bay, Quilcene, WA.

When: Applications will be accepted until position is filled.

Job Description: The position will have hands on work with static and continuous algae production cultures to meet the ever expanding needs of a large shellfish hatchery. Employee will work closely with current technicians, as well as the other hatchery staff. The position will help with all aspects of algae rearing, including general quality control, cleaning tubes and tanks, mixing of chemicals and vitamins, transfers of sterile algae, and the upkeep of the algae bag system, etc. This is a very physically demanding position that will include climbing ladders in and out of large tanks, standing and working on concrete floors, and being on the go most of the day.

Requirements/ Qualifications:

- Must be able to work independently and in teams
- Must be self motivated and organized
- Should have good time management skills
- Must be able to work weekends
- A science background and general knowledge of algae is preferred
- Must be able to carry out repetitive tasks
- Should be able to lift 50 lbs without difficulty and be able to work in a physically challenging environment
- Must have good communication skills

Benefits

- Health benefits become effective the 1st of the month following the waiting period of 60 days for eligible employees who work a minimum of 30 hours per week or a bay worker working an average of 20 hours per week. The employee is eligible for 401K after two full months of work prior to July 1st or January 1st and must be over 21 years old.
