

## **FLUPSY Technician**

### **Job Description**

Seeking to fill part time position with possibility of full time employment at Jamestown Point Whitney Shellfish at our Sequim Bay Floating Upweller Systems (FLUPSYs)

### **Summary**

The ideal candidate will possess a variety of skills including building, plumbing, mechanical and electrical knowledge, interest in marine biology and ecology, and organizational skills that will allow the technician to become familiar with cleaning, feeding, harvesting, inventorying, and the operation and maintenance of equipment and systems.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities**

Duties include but not limited to:

- Maintain cleanliness of shellfish bins and FLUPSY structure.
- Sort shellfish by size and species.
- Track and report inventory
- Maintain company assets in good operational condition including pumps, motors, blowers, and various tools.
- Must be able to work independently and within a team setting.
- Must be a self-starter and possess the ability to multi-task.
- Perform other duties, as assigned

### **Qualifications**

The requirements listed below are representative of the qualifications necessary to successfully perform the job.

#### **A. Education and/or Experience**

Preferred:

- High School Diploma with courses in Life Sciences
- Maritime operations
- Systems maintenance
- Construction, electrical and plumbing

#### **B. Certificates, Licenses, Registrations or Other Requirements**

- Valid Driver's License

#### **C. Other Knowledge, Skills or Abilities Required**

- Ability to write routine reports and correspondence.
- Ability to speak effectively before groups of customers or employees of organization.
- Ability to apply concepts of basic algebra and geometry.
- Experience with Excel and Word.

### **Physical Requirements**

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by a team member to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the team member is:

- Standing. Particularly for sustained periods of time.
- Walking. Moving about on foot to accomplish tasks.

- Use hands to finger, handle, or feel and talk or hear.
- Reaching. Extending hand(s) and arm(s) in any direction.
- Grasping. Applying pressure to an object with the fingers and palm.
- Talking. Expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word. Those activities in which they must convey detailed or important spoken instructions to other workers accurately, loudly, or quickly.
- Hearing. Perceiving the nature of sounds at normal speaking levels with or without correction. Ability to receive detailed information through oral communication, and to make the discriminations in sound.
- Regularly required to lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.
- Occasionally required to stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. Repetitive motion. Substantial movements (motions) of the wrists, hands, and/or fingers.
- The worker is required to have visual acuity to determine the accuracy, neatness, and thoroughness of the work assigned (i.e., custodial, food services, general laborer, etc.) or to make general observations of facilities or structures (i.e., security guard, inspection, etc.)

### **Working Conditions**

The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those a team member encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this Job, the team member is exposed to:

- Work in the outdoors in all seasons
- Work around heavy equipment and marine vessels
- Wet and/or humid conditions and extreme heat or cold
- Moderate noise level
