Job Description: Work with static and continuous larval production cultures to meet the ever expanding needs of a large shellfish hatchery. Employee will work closely with current larval technicians as well as other hatchery staff. This is a very physically active position including climbing ladders in and out of large tanks, standing and working on concrete floors and being on the go most of the day.
