

## **<u>Revised</u>** Notice of Application and Public Hearing

The **Public Hearing** date for **Taylor Shellfish's** Shoreline Substantial Development and Shoreline Conditional Use Permit (SHR2023-00003) has been changed to **Wednesday, August 9, 2023, at 1:00 pm** 

The proposed project will go before the Mason County Hearing Examiner via Zoom and at 411 N 5th St, Shelton, WA. Notice is hereby given that **Taylor Shellfish**, who is the <u>applicant</u> for the following proposal, has filed an application for a Shoreline Substantial Development and Shoreline Conditional Use Permit (SHR2023-00003) to grow Pacific oysters and install a floating oyster bag system in Oakland Bay. At full installation, an estimated 9.1 acres of surface water within a 50-acre area will be used for floating oyster gear. A Habitat Management Plan and a Macroalgae and Eelgrass Study have been completed for the project.

The proposed development is reviewed under the applicable chapters of the Shoreline Master Program, Resource Ordinance, and Title 15 Regulations. The proposal requires Hearing Examiner approval, with final approval with the Department of Ecology. A SEPA Determination of Non-Significance was issued on April 19, 2023. The formal 14-day comment period though SEPA ended on May 4, 2023.
